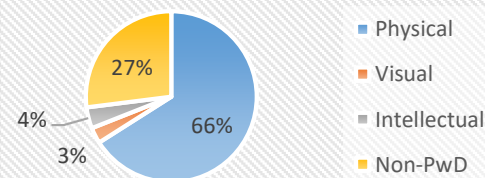

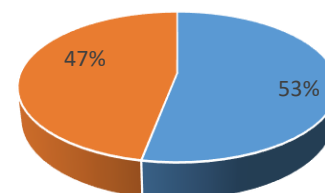

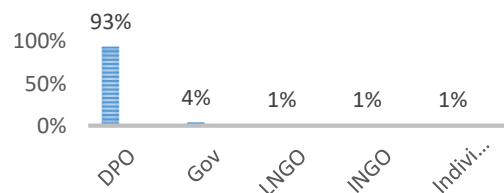
Overall Beneficiaries :

Date and Duration of Activity – 16-18 Nov 2018(3-day duration)

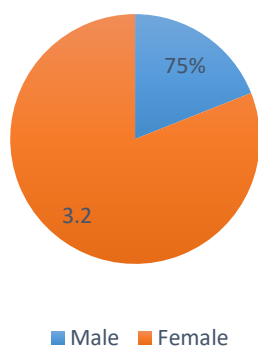
Location – Central Hotel, Yangon

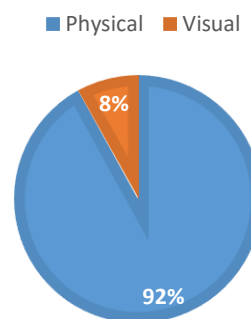

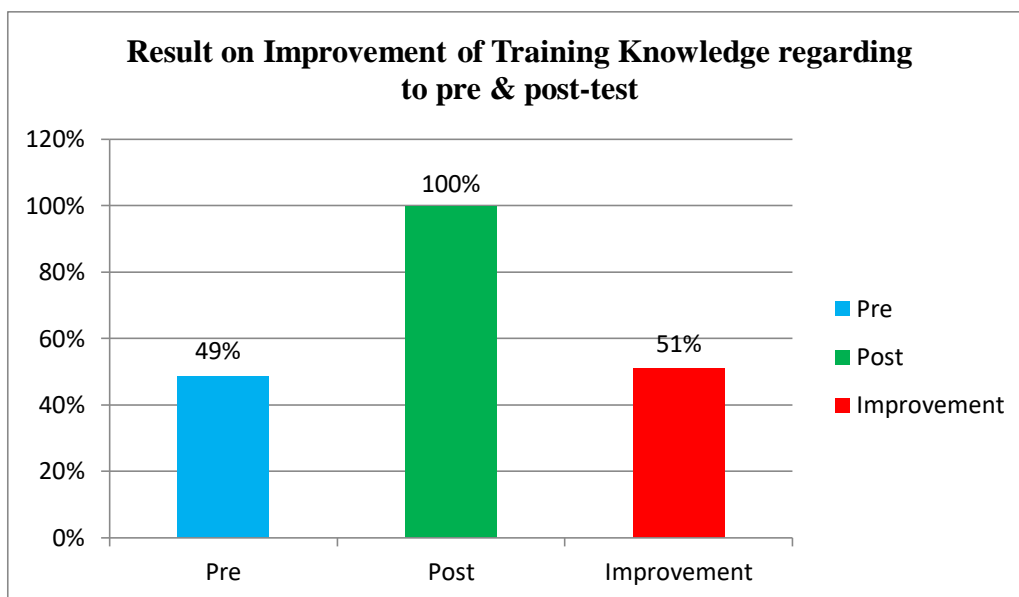
- Sit team meeting and develop training design

Date and Duration of Activity – 8 December 2018(1 day)

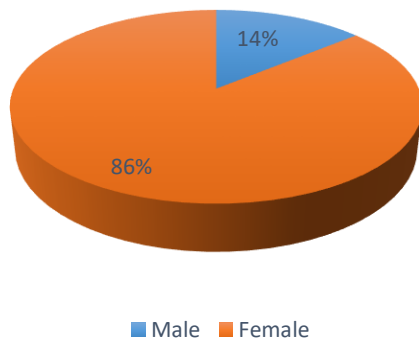
Location – Public Center, Taunggyi

Summary of Activity – Awareness training on law and by-law was conducted at Public Centre, Taunggyi with total (21) participants for one day on 8 December 2018.

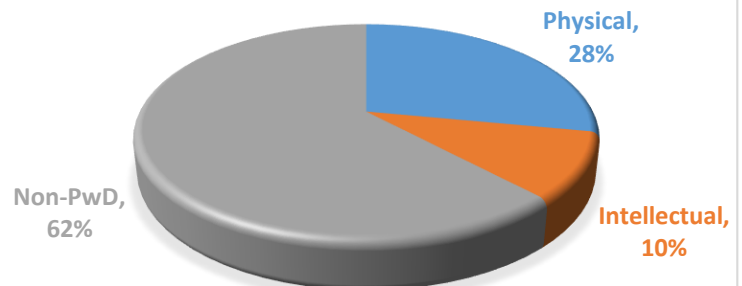

Date and Duration of Activity – 16 December 2018(1 day)

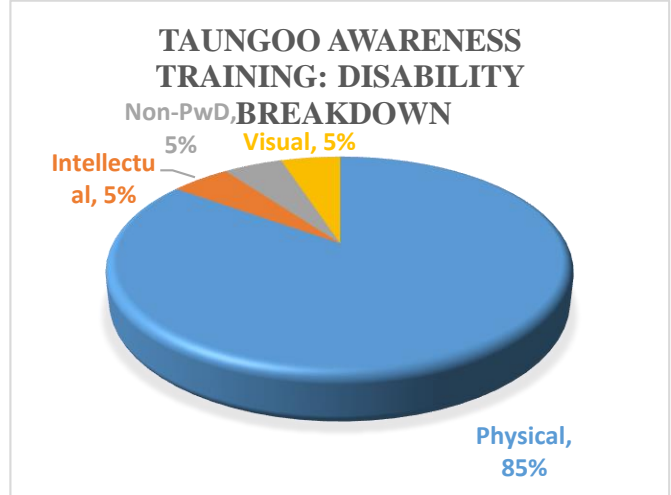
Location – Pathi Hotel, Taungoo

Date and Duration of Activity – 26 December 2018(1 day)

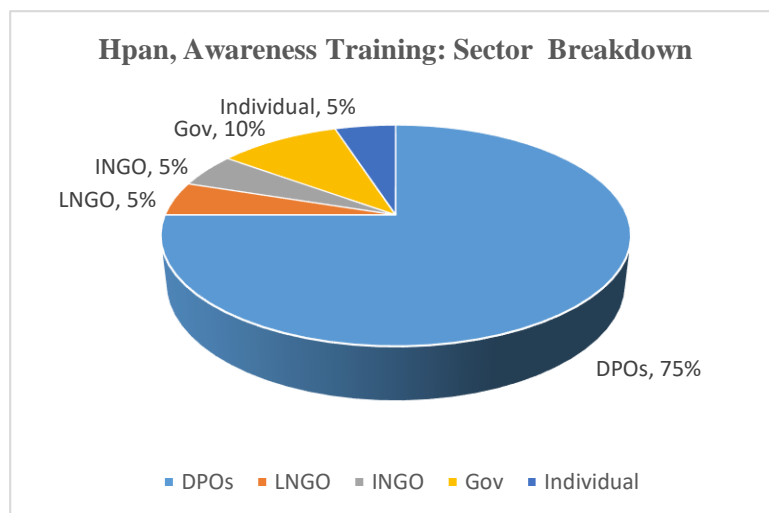

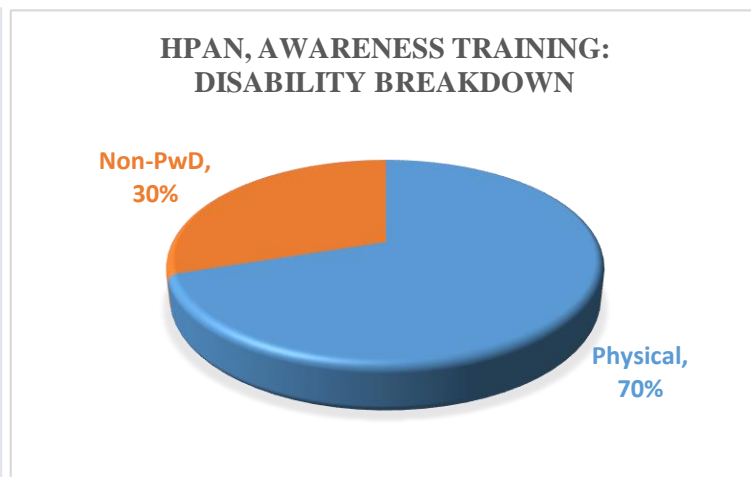
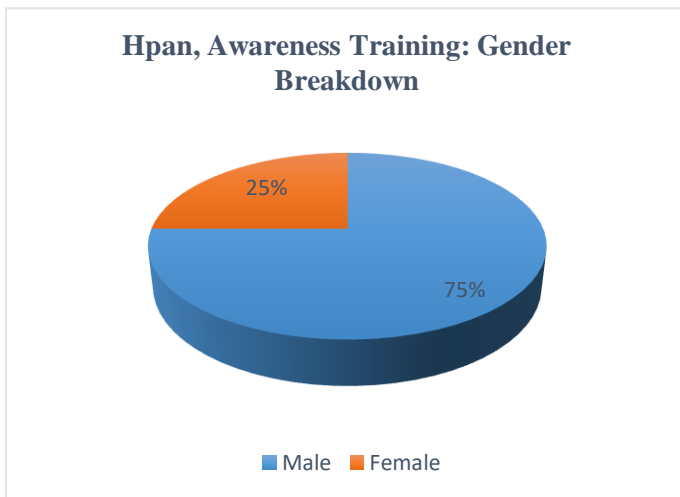
Stakeholder engagement – Representative from Department of Disaster Management (DSW) joined the training.

4.5) Activity Title – Production of law and by-law into accessibilities format

Summary of Activity – Law and by-law on the rights of PwDs was produced into 5 versions for accessibility of PwDs to ensure their rights.

- 1) Original Myanmar Language
- 2) Karen Language (Sakaw)
- 3) Shan Language (Shan Gyi)
- 4) Braille Language (New Version)
- 5) Audio Version

Methodology and Steps done for Production of Law and by-law

- o Work for the typing on by-law (law is already done)
- o Make proved reading on law and by-law and check typing error
- o Contact to translators and service to convert the law and by-law to accessibility versions
- o Discuss with translators and service to get the most popular version of intended language
- o Produce sample books
- o Make proved reading for correct term and terminologies
- o Make the production process
- o Disseminate the different version of law and by-law to different stakeholders
- o Follow up the whole process and benefit of the activity

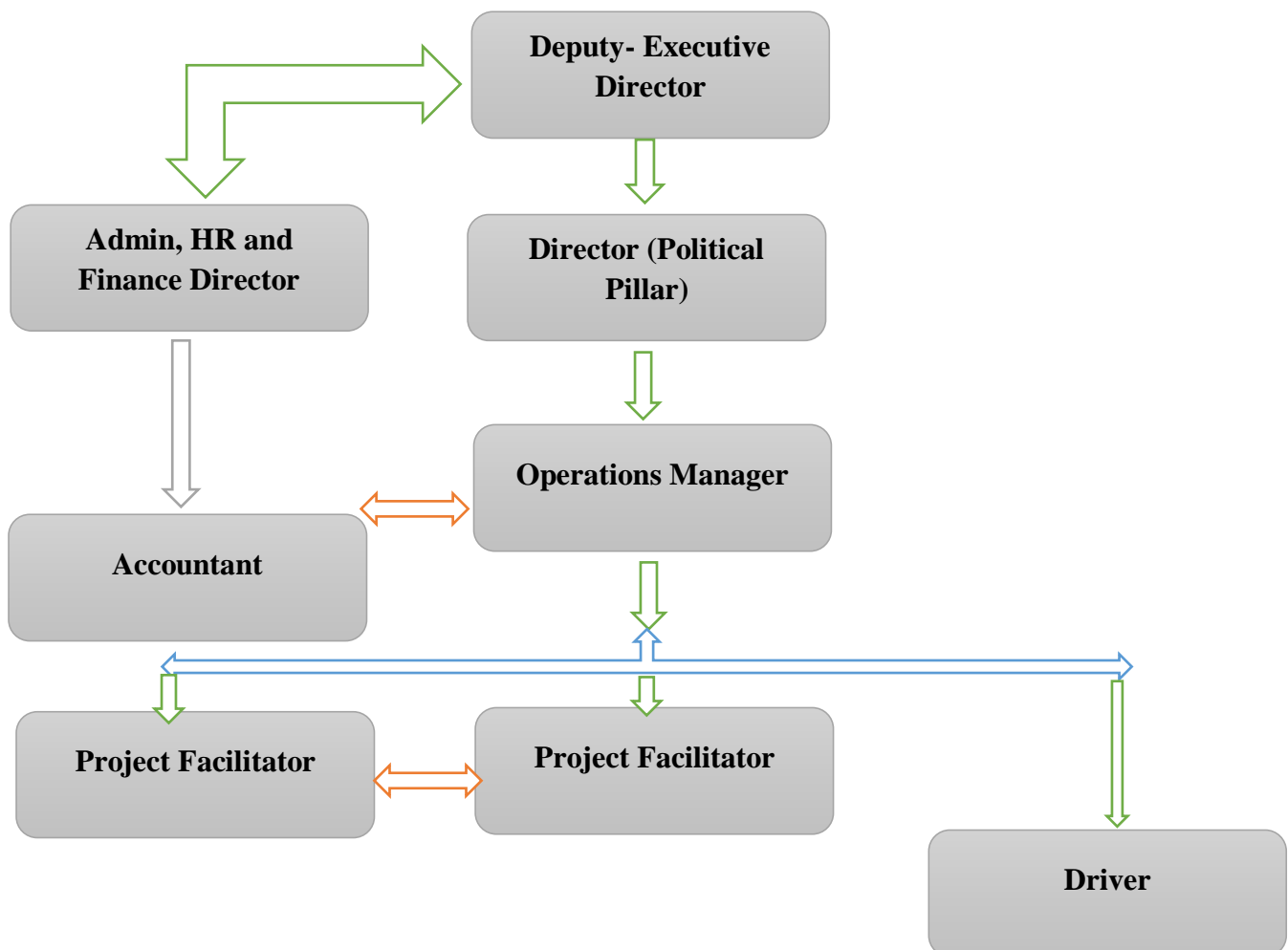
